Professor Michelle Scherer is Chair of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at The University of Iowa. Dr. Scherer's expertise is in environmental geochemistry including redox reactions at mineral-water interfaces and contaminant fate in soils and sediments. She has published over 50 journal articles and her work has been cited more than 2,000 times. She has been recognized with the Malcolm Pirnie/AEESP Frontier in Research Award in 2010, as well as the University of Iowa, College of Engineering 2007 Award for exceptional research. She is a member of EPA's Environmental Engineering Scientific Advisory Board and served as Associate Editor for *Environmental Science & Technology*.
